## **Scottish Hangings**

Talking about history, do you know about the amazing new tartan dedicated to those poor women who were tried and executed by the Scottish state for supposed sorcery between the 16th and 18th century under the Witchcraft Act 1563 – 1736?



Designed by the Witches of Scotland and the fabulous Clare Campbell of Prickly Thistle
Textiles, it will be woven to make products that help create a 'living memorial'. The black and grey are representative of the dark times of this period and the ashes of those burned. The design also

incorporates red and pink, symbolic of the legal tapes used to bind papers both during that time and still now. The thread count incorporates the years 1563 and 1736, shown in black and grey, surrounding white checks of 3 threads repeated 3 times, representing the core objectives of the organisation: ensure a pardon, receive an apology, retain a memorial.
